

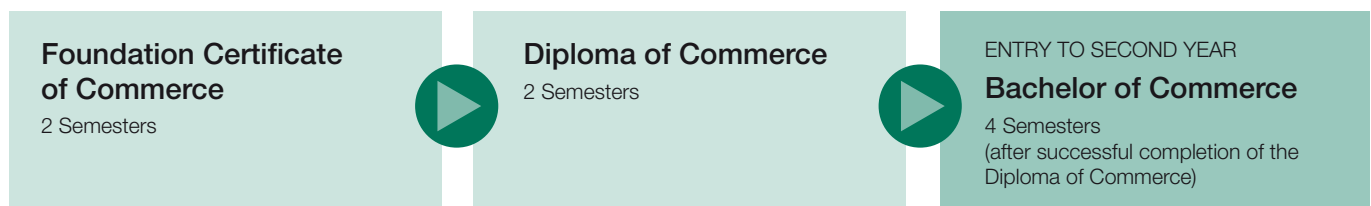


Pathway Programs to Curtin Singapore

Students who do not automatically receive entry to the Curtin Singapore Bachelors program can begin their university studies with the Foundation Certificate of Commerce and the Diploma of Commerce.

Successful completion of the Certificate leads to entry into the Diploma, which is identical to the first year of the Bachelors Degree. The Diploma course provides guaranteed entry into the

2nd year of Curtin Singapore's Bachelor of Commerce (all available majors) to students who complete the course successfully. The pathway entry structure is outlined.



Foundation Certificate of Commerce

The Foundation Certificate of Commerce is a pre-university course. The Certificate requires two semesters of full-time study and is designed to prepare students for university study. Students complete four units in each semester. Completion of the Certificate leads to the Diploma program

Semester 1

- Communications
- Introduction to Computing
- Mathematics or Statistics
- Accounting

Semester 2

- Economics
- Management
- Marketing
- Legal Studies

Diploma of Commerce

This course is designed to provide a flexible pathway for students who don't quite meet the academic entry requirements to join the Curtin Bachelor of Commerce directly. The Diploma is the equivalent of year one at undergraduate level.

Semester 1

- Accounting 100
- Economics 100
- Business Law 100
- Marketing 100

Semester 2

- Business Information Systems 100
- Management 100

Two electives* from:

- Communication in Business 201
- Business Statistics 101
- Economics (Macro) 101
- Law (Contract) 101
- Accounting (Managerial) 101
