It is designed for students who do not hold a bachelor's degree that meets the criteria for direct master's entry, including students with an associate degree, advanced diploma, or a non-recognised bachelor's degree.

Completion of the DipPP enables students to progress to one of the following Masters degrees at the University of Waikato – Business and Management, Digital Business, Supply Chain Management, Applied Finance, Professional Accounting, Legal Studies, Nursing Practice, Environment and Society, Security and Crime Science, Information Technology and Technology Innovation in Business.


