At The College, Swansea University

The College, Swansea University has launched a new Foundation in Nursing and Healthcare that will be available for September 2025 entry.

This Pathway will allow students the opportunity (subject to meeting all <u>progression requirements</u>, as detailed on the next page) to progress onto BSc Adult Nursing at Swansea University which is accredited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC).

On progression to Swansea University, students on BSc Adult Nursing will benefit from up to 2,300 hours of clinical practice within the NHS, be eligible to apply for Registered Nurse status with the NMC and to register as a nurse for work in EU and EEA.

BSc Adult Nursing graduates working in the UK can expect a starting salary of over £28,000 rising to over £57,000 for experienced staff.

The Details

Entry Requirements for Foundation Pathway

Students hoping to study the Nursing and Healthcare Foundation will be required to provide:



- 5x GCSEs at A-E grade OR 28 UCAS points (new) in AS, with a Grade C or equivalent in GCSE Mathematics
- UKVI IELTS 5.5 (no skill below 5.0) OR an appropriate equivalent
- A high quality Personal Statement
- Successful completion of an Admissions Interview before receiving an Unconditional
 Offer. This interview will be similar to our standard admissions interviews but will have
 a focus on healthcare. Students will only be eligible for this interview once all other
 conditions have been met. Please note that demand is high for this Foundation Pathway
 and spaces are limited.

Progression Requirements for BSc Adult Nursing

In order to progress from the Foundation Pathway to BSc Adult Nursing, students must:



- Pass all Nursing and Healthcare Foundation Pathway modules
- Pass a Police check/DBS equivalent at own cost*
- Pass a <u>Swansea University Occupational Health Check</u>*
- Pass an in-person interview with Swansea University's School of Nursing

Students who pass all modules but fail one of more of the other requirements will be transferred to <u>International Year One BSc Health and Social Care</u>. As a Health and Social Care graduate, a wealth of careers are open to you in the NHS, social services, civil services, charitable organisations and more.
