Why study Pre-sessional English (PSE)?

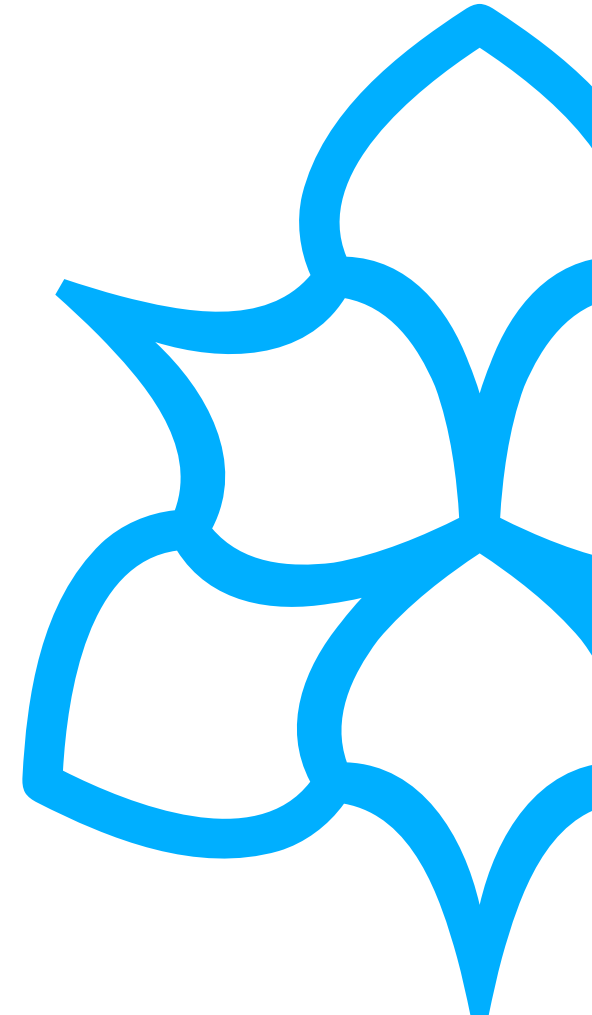
- For students who require extra support to meet the English Requirement at the International College.

- Improve academic English skills.
- Progress to pathway programme after passing. No need to retake IELTS.

Course content

- Full-time intensive course, with up to 21 hours/week.
- Interactive tasks and self-study.
- Regular 1:1 tutor meetings
- Study academic English skills:
 - Reading, writing, speaking, listening
 - Critical thinking
 - Conversation practice
 - Pronunciation



Admissions Requirements

- A SELT is required for students who require a CAS (unless student already has CEFR B2).
- Non-SELT English Qualifications can be considered for online delivery – please contact us for further equivalencies.
- In-person students will receive a single CAS for the PSE, unless they have a SELT at B1 (IELTS 5.5) with only one component at B1 (5.0).
- Students must be 18 when they start their PSE course (online or in-person).
- Due to immigration challenges we are not able to consider 'high risk' students for PSE courses (online or in-person).

Student journey to our International College

No separate PSE application needed - applicants will be referred to Manchester Met once they meet the conditions on your offer and provide an eligible English qualification.

- 1 Apply to the International College.
- 2 Receive your offer.
- 3 Meet the conditions of your offer and provide an eligible English qualification.
- 4 Confirm your interest in PSE and choose your preferred mode of study.

- 5 Get referral and receive PSE offer from Manchester Met.
- 6 Accept and pay Manchester Met for PSE.
- 7 Receive academic offer from the College. Accept and pay deposit for your academic course.

- Joint CAS
- 8 Receive your joint-CAS (if you meet the requirements).
 - 9 Apply for your visa.
 - 10 Complete your in-person PSE course to the required level.
 - 11 Progress to your course at the International College.

- Single CAS
- 8 Receive your CAS for PSE course
 - 9 Apply for your visa.
 - 10 Complete your in-person PSE course to the required level.
 - 11 Receive your CAS for your academic programme and apply for your visa.
 - 12 Progress to your course at the International College.

- Online study
- 8 Complete your online PSE course to the required level.
 - 9 Receive your CAS for your academic programme.
 - 10 Apply for your visa.
 - 11 Progress to your course at the International College.
