Around 3,000 students have successfully completed the program, with 98% progressing to tertiary study.

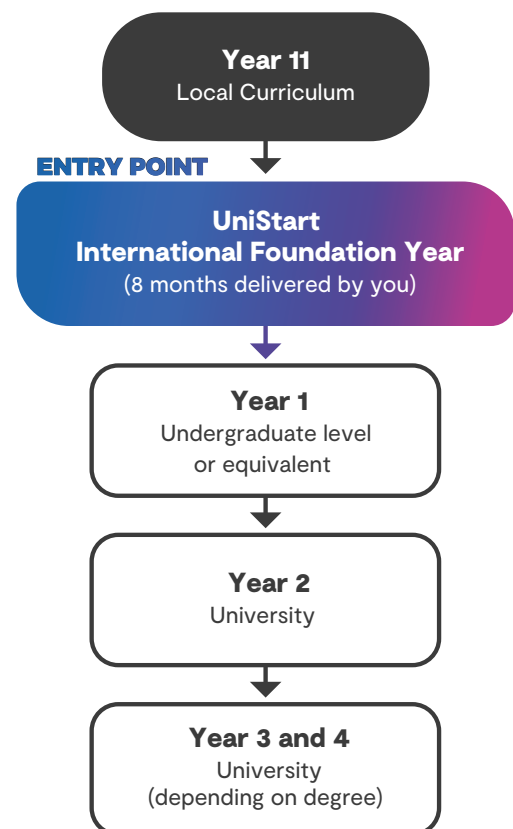

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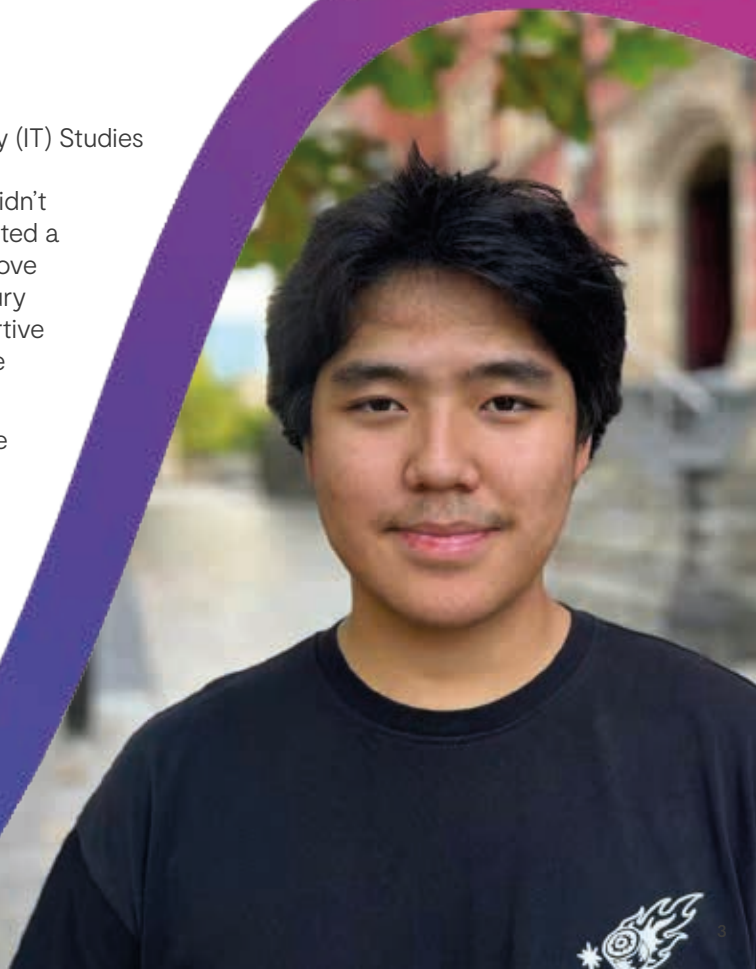
